

Nursery Music Progression Document

<u>Autumn A & B</u>	<u>Spring A & B</u>	<u>Summer A & B</u>
<u>Objectives –</u> Remember and sing entire songs. Sing the pitch of a tone sung by another person ('pitch match').	<u>Objectives -</u> Sing the melodic shape (moving melody, such as up and down, down and up) of familiar songs. Play instruments with increasing control to express their feelings and ideas.	<u>Objectives -</u> Create their own songs, or improvise a song around one they know.
<u>Activities –</u> During daily phonics sessions children will be exposed to a range of Nursery Rhymes. Adults will sing Nursery Rhymes and the children will recite the songs back in the same pitch. Children will learn Christmas songs for their Christmas performance. They will sing entire songs and practise actions.	<u>Activities –</u> During daily phonics sessions while learning new songs children will begin to look at different percussions their body can make. Once children know the different body percussions they can make children will be encouraged to put it to music. Clapping to the beat of a song initially then adding in a clap and a foot stomp.	<u>Activities –</u> To be able to change some words of Nursery rhymes. Children will be shown how we can change the words but keep the rhythm the same. Daily phonics sessions will provide lots of opportunities for children to participate in these activities.
