

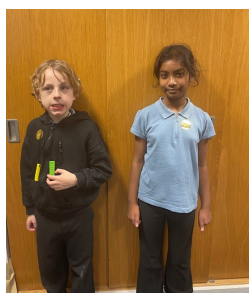


Happy New Year!
