We will now have stalls selling cakes, new and nearly new toys, games, books and household items.

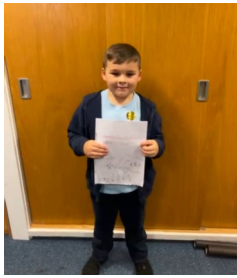
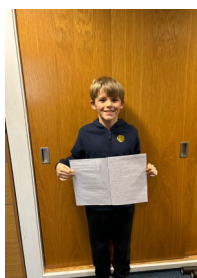
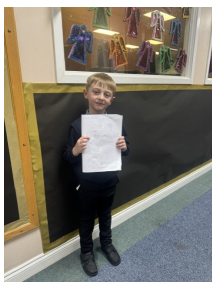

Fidgets in school

We have noticed a considerable increase in the number of fidgets being brought in from home. Fidgets can be helpful in classrooms- particularly for children with ADHD, anxiety, or sensory needs as they provide a quiet and discreet way to manage restlessness, focus, and self-regulate.

The aim is to help children concentrate in class; however, some of the fidgets which have been brought into school recently are causing more distraction for the child and other peers around them as they are being used more like toys.



Each classroom already has a number of fidgets in them which are available as and when teachers, TAs or a pupil feel they would benefit from one. This will still be encouraged by staff when appropriate. To help minimise distractions and to reduce the chance of fidgets being lost or accidentally broken please can we ask that children do not bring their own fidgets in from home to use in the classroom.
