If your child brings grapes into school in their packed lunch, can you please ensure they are sliced/cut into pieces.

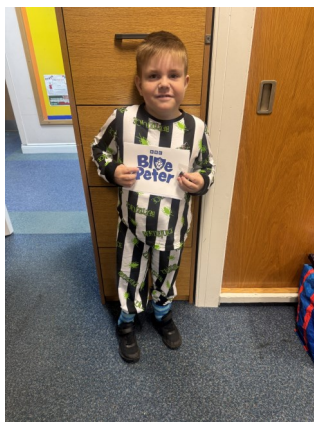
