Nasal and Intramuscular Flu Vaccination Consent Form

Your child is due to have their flu vaccine. The school session is booked for **13/11/2025**.

The vaccine helps protect your child from flu. Flu can make people feel very unwell and can be serious. The vaccine also helps stop flu spreading to family and friends.

Most children will get the nasal spray. Some children may need the injection instead. This might be because of health, religion, or diet.
