A gentle reminder that this is only 3 weeks away and balances are due prior to the trip unless a payment plan has already been discussed with Mrs Darby.

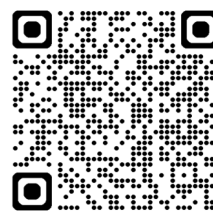
