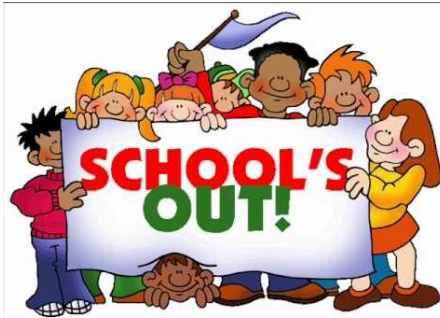




School breaks up for Summer today! We return back on Tuesday 2nd September.
