There has been some changes to the timings for Sports Days (dates remain the same).

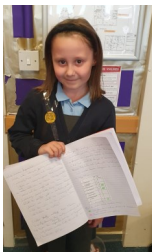

Please make every effort to come along, this will give parents/carers an opportunity to ask any questions they have.

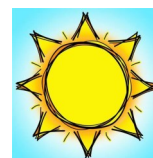


Dinner Money Increase

We will also be holding a raffle with sports prizes, which will run exactly the same as our easter equivalent.

It will be drawn on the non-uniform day (Friday 13th June), children will be encouraged to wear football kits or sporting attire and donate whatever they can to the charity.

90% of the funds raised will go to Soccer Aid for UNICEF and the other 10% to Kingsley Primary School to cover some of the cost of our summer sporting events.
