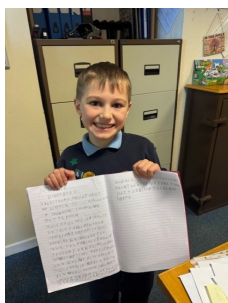

This summer we are hosting a few events and have decided to raise money for Soccer Aid for UNICEF.

The annual match is being played on Sunday 15th June and will be live on ITV.

We will also be holding a raffle with sports prizes, which will run exactly the same as our easter equivalent.

Every child will receive one ticket and extra tickets can be purchased in class for 10p each from Monday 2nd June.

It will be drawn on the non-uniform day (Friday 13th July), children will be encouraged to wear football kits or sporting attire and donate whatever they can to the charity.

90% of the funds raised will go to Soccer Aid for UNICEF and the other 10% to Kingsley Primary School to cover some of the cost of our summer sporting events.
